


The Luxembourg Proactive Mitigation Strategy

Goal: Carry out de-confinement as quickly and safely as possible by:

- > Minimising the risk of exit measures through large-scale testing of contingents (identifying and isolating more infected people before they can infect others)
- > Effectively monitoring the spread of the virus through methods including statistical analyses, to be able to adapt to the situation and keep the virus under control



Over the course of the coming months, each contingent is tested for SARS-CoV-2 (PCR from oral swabs, on a voluntary basis) in different locations



PCR test to detect the presence of SARS-CoV-2





Virus-free asymptomatic people



SARS-CoV-2 **positive** individuals (with or without symptoms)

Lifting of the restriction:

- > Back to work / school
- Repeated testing of smaller samples at regular intervals

(the security measures must still be followed: social distancing, wearing masks, etc.)

Restrictions remain:

- > Domestic isolation
- > Health-care if necessary
- > Identification of the contacts and their testing

¹The composition of the contingents and the timing of the testing will be defined by the government. The COVID-19 Task Force recommends however to consider among others the following aspects: age distribution and amount of people in the sector; working conditions (e.g. how easily social distancing is possible at work, if home office is possible, etc.); economic impact of the sector.
